

CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF RENFREW  
BY-LAW NO. 44-2020

Being a by-law to repeal By-Law No. 30-2020 and  
By-Law No. 31-2020.

WHEREAS on March 11, 2020 the World Health Organization declared a worldwide pandemic regarding the Novel Coronavirus 19 ("COVID-19 pandemic"); and

WHEREAS on March 17, 2020 a Declaration of Emergency was made by the Province of Ontario pursuant to section 7 .0.1 of the Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. E.9 (the "Emergency Management Act") related to COVID-19; and

WHEREAS the Province of Ontario's modelling projects that the COVID-19 Emergency will last months and will place severe and long term pressures on our health care system and present unprecedented economic challenges; and

WHEREAS at its meetings held on March 24, 2020 and April 28, 2020, Renfrew Town Council deemed it prudent to provide, at the local level, additional support to property owners in the form of the waiving of identified penalties and interest on taxes, and water/sewer bills, during this unprecedented time of uncertainty and financial hardship; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Renfrew now deems it desirable and timely to divert back to imposing penalty and interest charges as provided for in By-Law No. 2-2020 (taxation) and By-Law No. 29-2016, as amended (water/sewer).


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Renfrew hereby enacts as follows:

1. THAT By-Law No. 30-2020 and By-Law No. 31-2020 be repealed in their entirety.
2. THAT this By-law shall come into force and take effect on July 1, 2020.

Read a first and second time this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of June, 2020.

Read a third time and finally passed this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of June, 2020.
