

CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF RENFREW  
BY-LAW NO. 58-2020

Being a by-law to amend By-Law No. 2-98, being  
a by-law to govern the operation of the Renfrew  
Public Library.

WHEREAS Section 3 of the *Public Libraries Act*, RSO 1990, c. P.44, authorizes council to establish a public library; and

WHEREAS Sections 9 and 10 of the *Public Libraries Act*, RSO 1990, c. P.44, provides for the composition of a Public Library Board and the qualifications of its members; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Renfrew, by virtue of the passing of By-Law No. 2-98, regulates the operation of the Renfrew Public Library, including the appointment of a Library Board to oversee the operation of the Library; and

WHEREAS the Renfrew Public Library Board has requested an amendment to Section 4 of By-Law No. 2-98 to take into consideration contracts with other municipalities for library services and the desire to appoint a lay-person representative from the contracting municipality to the Board; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Renfrew deems it expedient and in the best interests of the municipality to implement the requested amendment.


NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Renfrew enacts as follows:

1. THAT By-Law 2-98 be amended by the following:
  - a) by deleting Section 4:
    4. The Board shall consist of seven (7) persons appointed by Council, at least one (1), but not more than (2) of whom shall be members of the said Council. The remaining members of the Board shall be qualified lay appointees, in accordance with Section 10( 1) of the Public Libraries Act
  - b) by inserting a new Section 4:
    4. The Board shall consist of seven (7) persons appointed by Council, at least one (1), but not more than (2) of whom shall be members of the said Council. The remaining members of the Board shall be qualified lay appointees, in accordance with Section 10( 1) of the Public Libraries Act, and ensuring that one (1) of the aforementioned qualified lay appointees be appointed from each contracting municipality.
2. THAT this By-law shall come into force and take effect immediately upon its passage thereof.
