

CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF RENFREW  
BY-LAW NO. 68-2017

Being a by-law to award a professional services contract to J.L. Richards and Associates Limited required to prepare a conceptual design of the Renfrew Municipal Works Garage.

**WHEREAS** Sections 8 (1) and 9 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, provide that the powers of a municipality under this or any other Act shall be interpreted broadly so as to confer broad authority on the municipality to enable the municipality to govern its affairs as it considers appropriate and to enhance the municipality's ability to respond to municipal issues and has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority under this or any other Act; and

**WHEREAS** the 2016 capital budget included funds for the advancement of this project and by Council resolution on March 21, 2017, these funds were transferred to a Work In Progress Reserve to be utilized in 2017; and

**WHEREAS** through a public process, the Town of Renfrew released a Request for Proposal on July 20, 2017 and which closed on August 10, 2017; and


**WHEREAS** the proposal submitted by J.L. Richards and Associates Limited is recommended for adoption by the Development & Works Committee.


**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Renfrew hereby enacts:

1. **THAT** the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Renfrew approve of the awarding of the proposal from J.L. Richards and Associates Limited for the professional services required to prepare a conceptual design of the Renfrew Municipal Works Garage in the amount of \$71,547.46, inclusive of 1.76% HST.
2. **THAT** the Director of Development & Works be and is hereby authorized on behalf of the Corporation of the Town of Renfrew to do and execute all things, papers and documents necessary to the execution of this award.
3. **THAT** this By-law shall come into force and take effect immediately upon the passage thereof.

Read a first and second time this 10<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2017.

Read a third time and finally passed this 10<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2017.
