<u>CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF RENFREW</u> <u>BY-LAW NO.</u> 9-2019

Being a by-law to appoint community members to the Renfrew Public Library Board.

WHEREAS the Public Libraries Act, R.S.O. (1990), authorizes the Council of a local municipality to pass by-laws establishing and appointing members to a Public Library Board; and

WHEREAS the <u>Public Libraries Act</u>, R.S.O. (1990), Section 9(1), states that a public library board shall be composed of at least five members appointed by the municipal council; and

WHEREAS Town of Renfrew By-Law 2-98, being a by-law to govern the operation of the Public Library, states that the Board shall consist of seven (7) persons appointed by Council, at least one (1) but not more than two (2) of whom shall be members of the said Council, and that the remaining members of the Board shall be qualified lay appointees, in accordance with Section 10(1) of the Public Libraries Act, R.S.O. (1990); and

<u>WHEREAS</u> Councillor Andrew Evans and Councillor Arlene Jamieson have been appointed by the Mayor as Council's representatives on the Renfrew Public Library Board for the 2018-2022 term of Council; and

WHEREAS it has now been determined that only Councillor Evans serve as Council's representative to the Board, leaving six (6) vacancies to be filled by lay appointees.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Renfrew enacts as follows:

- THAT Donalda Clark, Heather Dale, Jane Donnelly, Lynda Janney, Margaret Maloney and Christin Miller, be appointed as members of the Renfrew Public Library Board for the 2018-2022 term of Council.
- THAT all appointees to this Board shall hold office until their successors are appointed.
- 3) **THAT** all predecessor by-laws inconsistent with this by-law be hereby repealed.
- THAT this By-Law shall come into force and take effect on the date of its passage.
