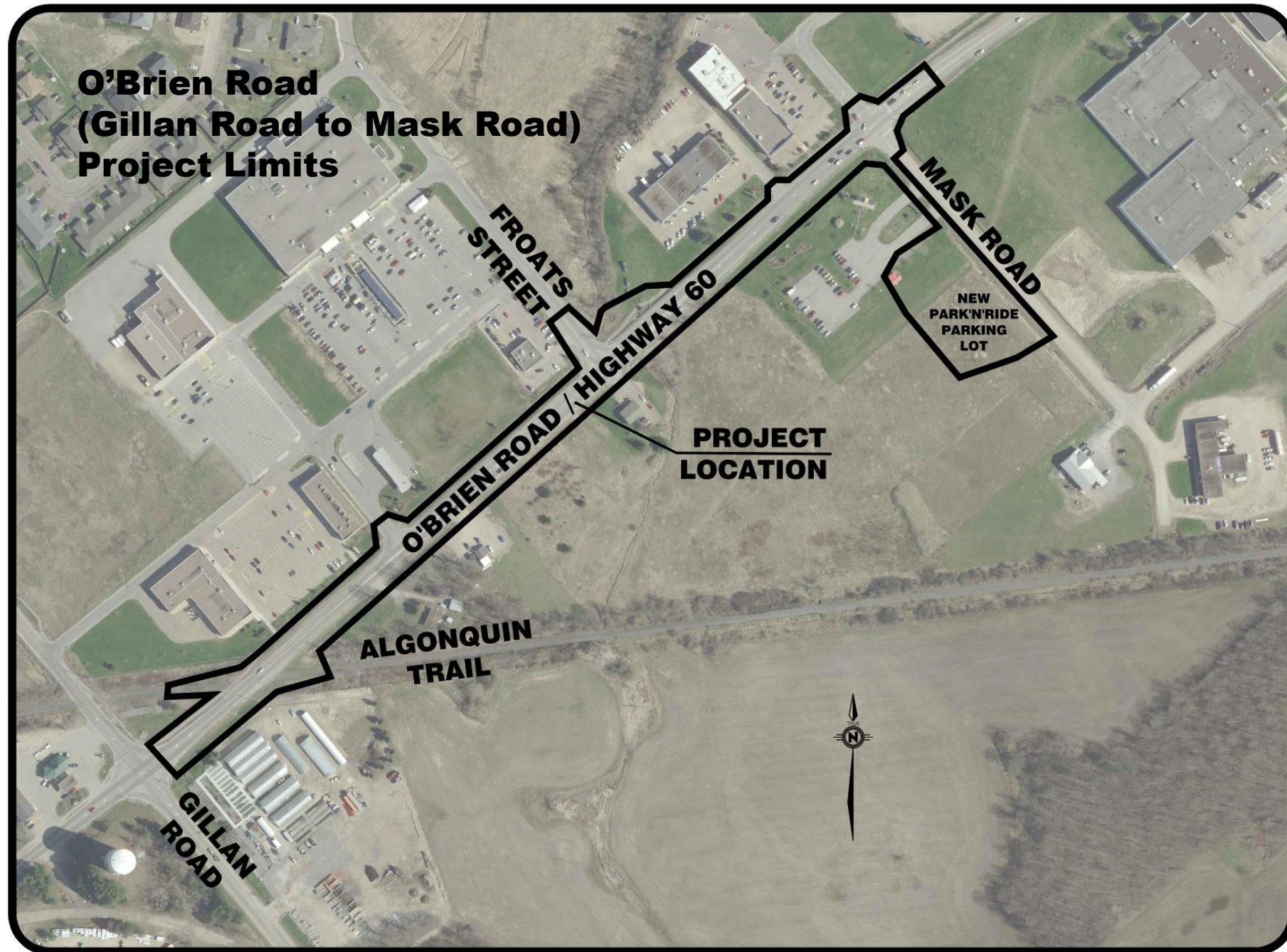

# O'Brien Road Reconstruction 2022


## Project Background

- This project is a part of multi-year Connecting Link Rehabilitation program that the Town has been undertaking on the portions of Highway 60 and Highway 132 that are within the Town's Limits
- The Ministry of Transportation (MTO) will be contributing up to \$3M in funding for the project.



# O'Brien Road Reconstruction 2022


## Project Scope

- 
- One through lane in each direction with one continuous central turning lane
  - Full depth pulverizing and repaving of existing lanes with widening into existing shoulder with new concrete barrier curb & gutter
  - New concrete sidewalk along southern side with grassed boulevard separation from driving lanes
  - Removal of existing concrete islands on O'Brien Road
  - New traffic signals at Froats Street and Mask Road intersections

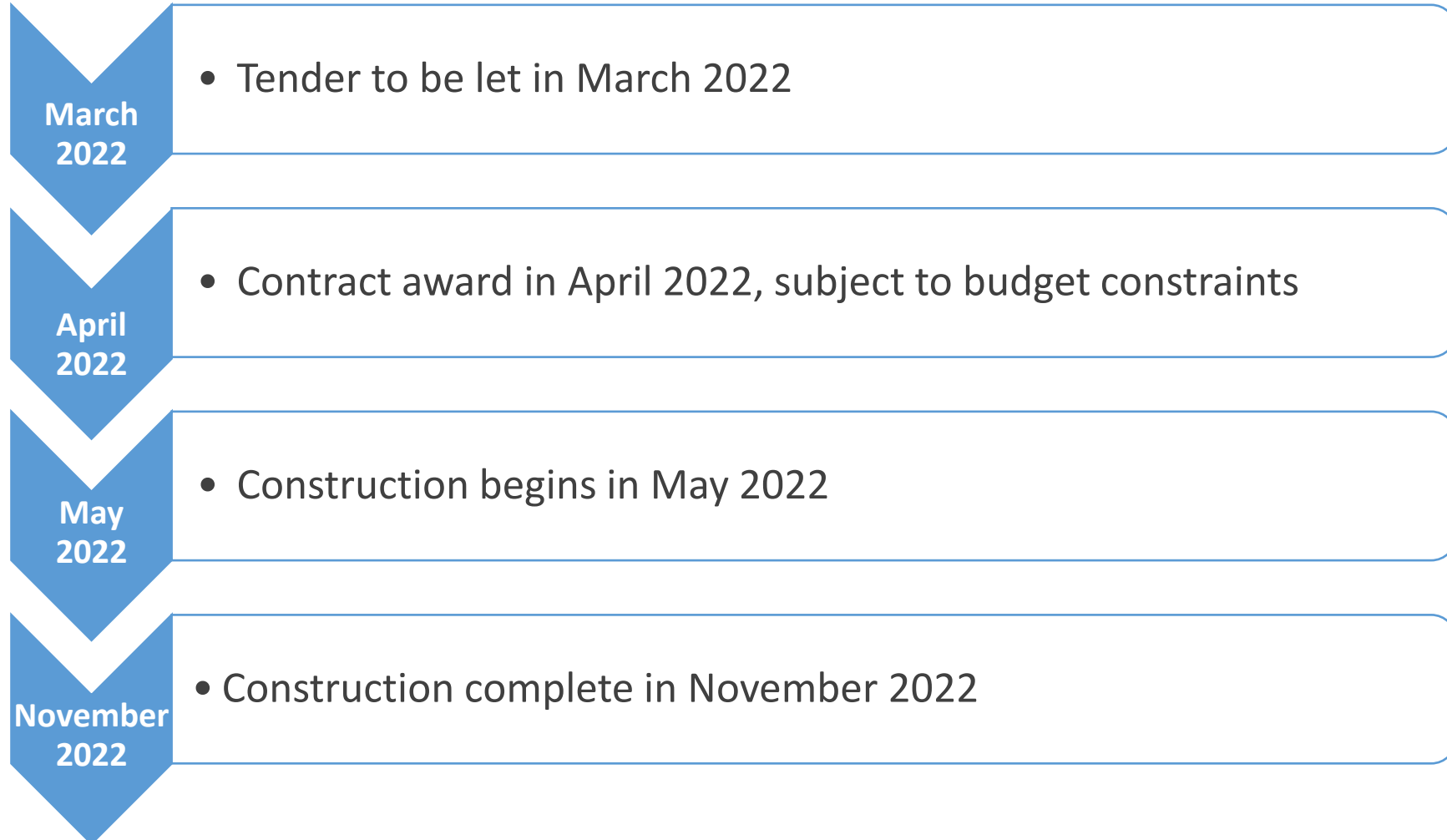
## Project Scope

- 
- New storm sewer system which will allow for the elimination of the ditch on the south side of the road
  - New Park & Ride parking lot on Mask Street
  - Re-alignment of Algonquin Trail crossing to make it more perpendicular to O'Brien Road. This is being completed in partnership with the County of Renfrew.
  - Line painting on O'Brien Road with new crosswalks, driveway tie-ins and lawn reinstatement

## Project Details - Preconstruction

### Preconstruction Survey

- At the start of construction, a representative of the Contractor will visit neighbouring properties to complete a preconstruction inspection to verify existing conditions.
- The preconstruction inspection is used to confirm preconstruction conditions should there be an issue during construction.
- A letter will be sent prior to construction to property owners that this will apply to.

### Project Updates

- A summary of the Contractor's proposed schedule and areas of work will be posted on the Town's website to keep residents advised of planned activities. This will be updated throughout the duration of the construction timeline



# O'Brien Road Reconstruction 2022

## Project Details – During Construction

### Service Interruptions

- Garbage & recycling will be picked up. If the Contractor is working in the area, then they may move the garbage and recycling outside the work area for pickup. The cans and bins will be picked up and returned to your property. Please put your house number on your cans and bins.
- Water service may be interrupted for a short time when reconnections are being made, but you will be advised before any planned shut off.
- Commercial entrances and driveways will be accessible except while work is being done in front of them. You will be advised, and arrangements made if access needs to be disrupted to complete work
- Driveways and lawns will be reinstated similar to preconstruction.
- Traffic flow along O'Brien Road will be maintained, however, some delays can be expected

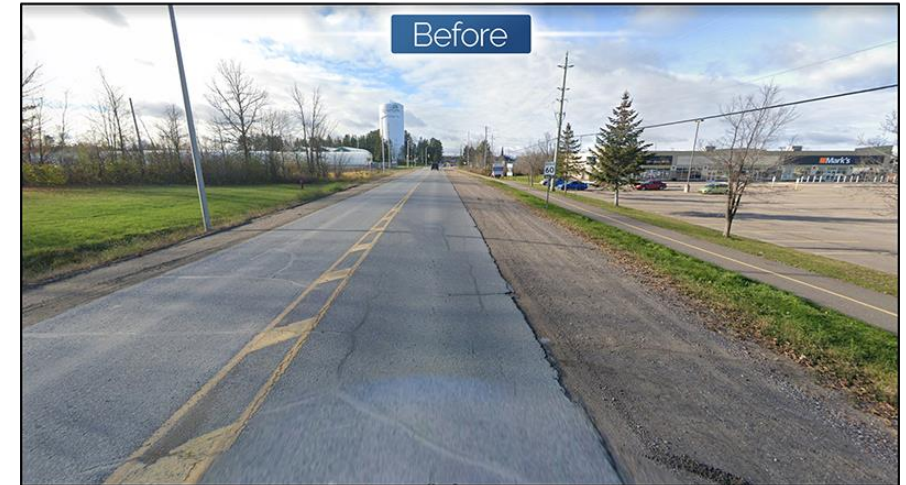


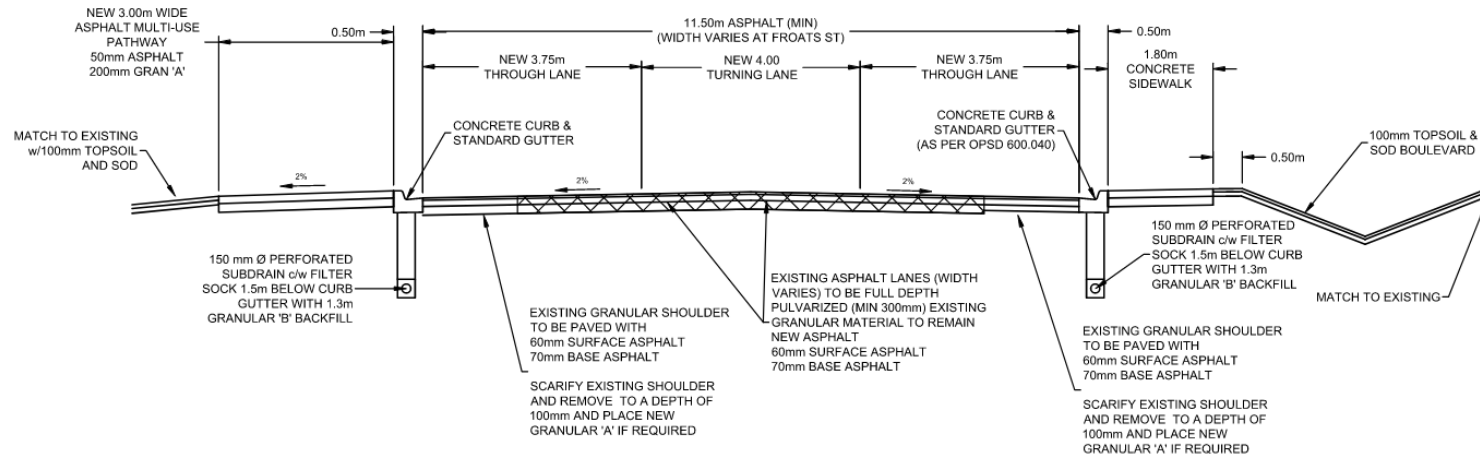


# O'Brien Road Reconstruction 2022

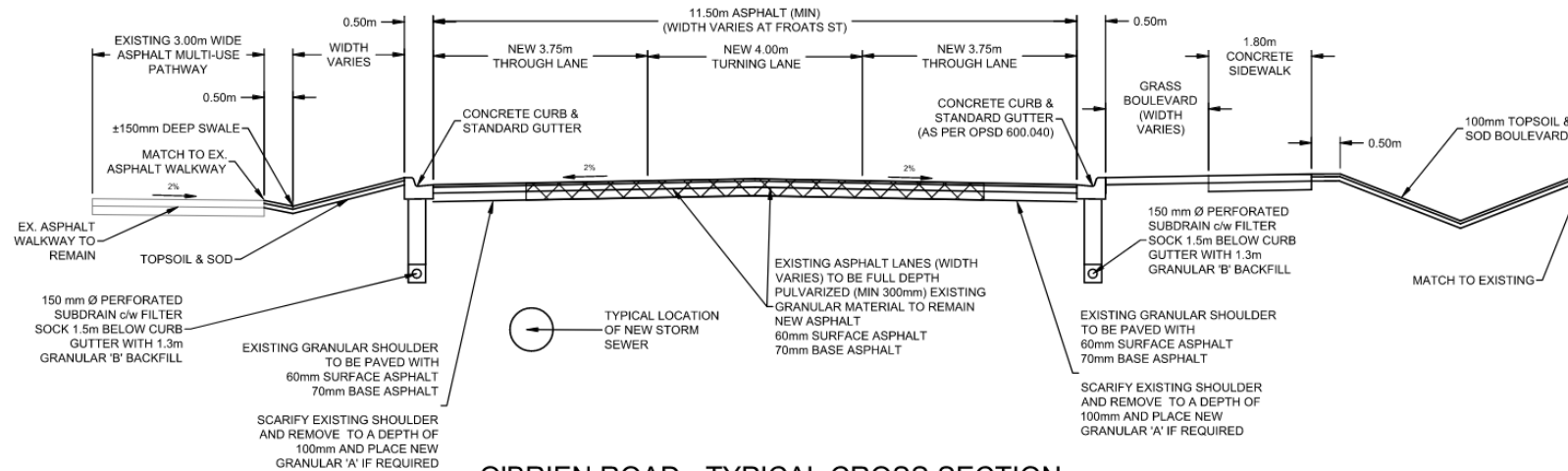
## Before & After 3D Rendering

- Upon completion, the road surface will be similar to this rendering as shown looking southward towards the Gillan Road intersection.
- The existing Multi-Use Pathway on the right side will remain and a new concrete sidewalk will be constructed along the south side (left in picture) with a grassed boulevard separating it from the driving lanes.
