Renfrew, Ontario – March 17, 2020

As the COVID-19 situation continues to progress and evolve the Town of Renfrew is actively engaged in ensuring we follow best practices and recommendations from Public Health Officials and Federal/Provincial Ministries.

EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY, ALL Town of Renfrew buildings and facilities (including the Renfrew Landfill site) are closed to the general public, until April 5, 2020, or until further notice.

The Town is maintaining essential services as we continue to monitor the situation with guidance from the Health Unit and other levels of government.

Garbage and recycling collection will continue as scheduled.
